

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION INFORMATION

ALL PLAYERS MUST register via the MyFootballClub

website: www.myfootballclub.com.au

All players around Australia must register via MyFootballClub website as clubs are unable to register players like previous years. Detailed instructions on how to do this are available through the aforementioned links or a “Quick Step Sign On Process” is provided on our website under the 2018 Sign On <tab>, for those who are familiar with type of process. If you are having any difficulties registering with My Football Club then we are happy to assist you on one of the designated sign on days.

It is important to note that when you register online with My Football Club you will be able to pay online after registering, however this will cost you an additional 2.3 percent associated with payment processing charges. Other payment options are available and if this is a requirement then there is an option for manual payment that can be selected, and payment can then be made at the clubhouse after you complete the online registration process.

Other payment options include:

- a) Debit or Credit card at the Club. Please note that a 2.8% fee will be passed on to you
- b) Direct deposit to the club’s bank account
- c) Debit Success contract completed at the club
- d) Cash or Cheque at the club
- e) Claim Get Started Voucher - If you have a Get Started Voucher, please bring to the clubhouse and a refund will be arranged.

Note: the Government Scheme opens on 27 January 2018. The number of vouchers available is limited and run out quickly once the application portal is opened. If, subsequent to registering, you obtain a voucher, please bring to the clubhouse and a refund will be arranged.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

For anyone requiring financial assistance with paying of their fees, please go through the registration process and then print out an invoice and bring to club on sign on days and we will be happy to sign you up with Debit Success Payment Plan.

GET STARTED PROGRAM

- Round 11 opens for voucher applications on **24 January 2017**.
- Round 11 will close when all available vouchers are issued. If the voucher allocation is not reached the round will close on designated expiry date in 2018.
