VENUE CHECK-IN INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

The Queensland Government has permitted full contact training and matches to go ahead during Stage 3 of the roadmap to easing restrictions, effective from July 3.

Proceeding with these football activities is now possible due to the Government's approval of the Industry COVID Safe Plan and Football Queensland's Return to Play guidelines.

Each club must adhere to the conditions contained in these documents, including the important protocols concerning contact tracing measures.

To reduce the administrative burden on clubs, Football Queensland has sourced a simple QR code solution that enables individuals to easily register their attendance at a football venue.

The information gathered is securely stored and only used to support relevant health authorities in the event somebody returns a positive test for COVID-19.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

STEP 1

With your mobile device, open the built-in camera app. Point the camera at the QR code and wait for it to recognise the QR code.

STEP 2

Once the QR code has been scanned, a notification containing a link should appear. If no link appears, enter the URL above into your web browser.

STEP 3

Once the link has loaded, fill out the fields and follow the on-screen prompts to finish the form. You will only need to complete this form the first time you scan the QR code.

STEP 4

Upon leaving the ground make sure you scan the QR code to check out.

WHERE WILL MY DATA BE STORED?

Check-in data is encrypted and stored on each person's device. Once someone checks in, the data is sent via an encrypted channel into Microsoft's Azure data centre in Australia. Clubs, zones and Football Queensland will only use this data if it is needed to communicate with health authorities.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A SMARTPHONE?

Queensland clubs have been advised to access Football Queensland's Record of Attendance template, which is available via the Return to Play Hub on footballqueensland.com.au. This form may be used to record details of attendees if the QR code for check-in is not in operation.
